



PARENT/GUARDIAN RULES

Wildcats Ice Hockey Club (WIHC) expects all parents to conduct themselves in an orderly, sportsmanlike and professional manner when attending a game, practice, or club activity of WIHC. Each parent will abide by the following fundamental ethical principles:

- Parents will always refrain from all verbal abuse, including profane language and mannerisms, of other spectators, players, coaches and/or officials.
- Parents will not make physical contact with any spectator, player, coach, official, league representative, and/or ice rink personnel.
- Parents will not taunt and/or threaten any spectator, player, coach, official, league representative, and/or ice rink personnel.
- Parents will not go into the locker room of an opposing team, obstruct access to said locker room and/or travel beyond the designated point of the hallway outside of the locker rooms at any time.
- Parents will not go into the officials' locker room and/or obstruct access to the said locker room at any time.
- Parents shall never enter the ice playing surface at any time unless specifically directed by an official.
- Parents shall never throw any object onto the ice playing surface.
- Parents shall refrain from pounding on the glass before, during and/or after a game.

- Parents shall never deface and/or destroy property belonging to any individual, team, club and/or ice rink.
- Parents shall never be involved in any activity that warrants the summoning of law enforcement officials.
- Parents shall never incite any person(s) to become involved in the above behaviors.
- Parents will adhere to the decisions of the officials. If asked to leave the stands and/or facility, one will do so without incident.
- Parents are not permitted to approach the player bench and/or speak to a coach during a game.
